Please be advised that during the calendar year of 2020, the Village Council will meet on the first and third Monday of each month in regular session, except on, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (January 20th), Presidents Day (February 17th), and Labor Day (September 7th) when meetings will be held on the next secular day that is not a holiday for village employees, unless another day is set by the council.

All council meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. at the Elk Rapids Community Governmental Center, 315 Bridge St, Elk Rapids, Michigan (231-264-9274 - Village Office phone).
