

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE
COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELK RAPIDS,
March 31, 1948, 7 P. M.

A Special meeting of the Common Council of the Village of Elk Rapids, was held in the City Hall on March 31, 1948,, for the purposes acting on the proposed gift of the so-called "Island House" property to the Village of Elk Rapids.

The meeting was called to order by President Zupin at 7 P. M.

Present:- President Zupin,
Trustees:- Core, Barnes, Ladd, Martinsen and Loop.
Clerk- La Bonte.

President Zupin presented a telegram from the attorneys representing the owners of the property, which set forth the gift to the Village.

After discussion of the matter the following resolution was moved by Trustee Martinsen, seconded by Barnes that:-

"Resolved that the Common Council of the Village of Elk Rapids hereby accepts the gift by Mrs. Stanley McCormick to said Village, of the property, known and commonly referred to as the "Island House."

The resolution was adopted by the unanimous vote of the Trustees. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 P. M.
