A regular meeting of the Elk Rapids Village Council was called to order at 8:00 P.M.P.

After the roll call the minutes of previous meeting were read, corrected and approved.  
The East Side Sewer complaints were considered by the Council and dropped because they were not feasible for the present assessed area.

A motion by Sobbry supported by Loomis that we issue a permit to Joseph Yuchasz a commercial building 24' X 60' of cement block with stone and brick facing on original plot of West Elk Rapids. Estimated cost: \$10,000. Carried all.
