

A regular meeting of the Elk Rapids Village Council was called to order at 8:00 P.M.
Present: President Ring; Trustees: Sobbry, Core, Hockstad, Gnad, Nelson, Loomis.

The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved as read.

A decision was made to set up a combined Village & Township board to work on a new Island House ordinance and to supervise the property in general. Members appointed for the village are: Kenneth Core (1) yr; Howard (Mrs.) Hockstad; Arthur Ring. Members appointed for the Township are: Mrs. Roy Warno (1) yr; Mr. Glenn Morrison (2) yrs. Supervisor Scott Morrison.

A motion by Hockstad supported by Loomis to repeal Island House ordinance and take necessary steps to write up a new ordinance with half ownership going to both Village and Township. Carried all.

A motion by Nelson supported by Hockstad that the following be appointed to the Harbor Committee to run to April 1961: For (1) yr Frank Sobbry, Ed Grace, Fred Venneersch. For (2) yr: Karl Holt, Lew McColley, Denny Converse. For (3) yr: Charles Lark Jr; Joe Yuchasz, Ivan Hubbell. Carried all.

An application was made by a Mr. Dodds to place a pop-corn stand on Front street. Council approval was given subject to conditions governing new business ordinance.

A motion by Loomis supported by Core that we purchase 2-20' lengths of pipe for an extension on the overflow on Fourth Street. Carried all.

A motion by Loomis supported by Gnad that we accept recommendations for proposed stop signs angle & parallel parking. Carried all.

A motion by Core supported by Hockstad that we charge \$1.00 ^{each} for water shut-off & turn on. Carried all.

A motion by Hockstad supported by Sobbry that we accept recommendations for a new East Side sign in accordance with the bid from Bayart's Products, Acme. Carried all.

A motion by Core supported by Hockstad that we donate \$ 25.00 to the Elk Rapids Cherry Queen. Carried all.

A motion by Loomis supported by Gnad that we donate \$10.00 to our Boy Scouts for cleaning Island House grounds. Carried all.

A motion by Core supported by Hockstad that we stop all hauling of sand from the sand hill. until further notice from the village. Carried all.

A motion by Hockstad supported by Loomis that we issue a building permit to Deborah Gibson to erect a 20' X 22' addition to her present residence. And to also issue a building permit to Mr. D.R. Converse to construct a 24' X 28' masonry garage on Lot 308. Carried all.

A motion by Loomis supported by Nelson for an advance on the Clerk's salary. Carried all.

A motion by Loomis supported by Sobbry to accept ordinance 64 as amended. Carried all.

A motion by Hockstad supported by Nelson that we accept checks for approval and to pay all small bills. Carried all.
